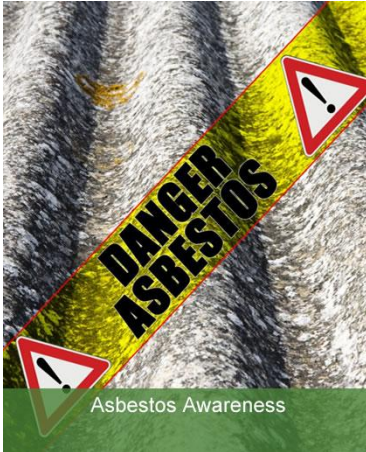




Asbestos awareness qualification is designed to ensure that anyone who may come into contact with asbestos based material knows what asbestos is, what it looks like, where it can be found, the dangers of asbestos and how to protect themselves from accidental exposure.

To achieve this qualification you must demonstrate your knowledge and understanding in line with the qualification specification.

There is ONE mandatory module to complete.

Areas that this asbestos awareness qualification course covers:-

- What is asbestos and what asbestos looks like
- Where it can be found
- Understanding the risks to health including asbestos-related death and health implications of asbestos exposure
- Preventing accidental asbestos exposure, raising awareness of what is required to do in an emergency if asbestos is encountered accidentally
- Legal duties

**Qualification Duration**

Candidates get twelve months to complete with full support from allocated assessor.

Entry Requirements

There are no set entry requirements for this qualification however English must be your first language or you are fluent in the English language. Candidates must be at least 16 years old on the day that they are registered for this qualification.

Assessment Methods

Assessment methods include completing knowledge tasks and question and answers on the online portal, verbally with your assessor over the telephone or completion of a handbook. On registering with us your allocated assessor will be in touch for your induction.

Process

To register on any of our qualifications you must complete the skills scan so we can carry out the initial assessment. The initial assessment is to ensure you are eligible and able to achieve the qualification. We can then register you and receive your login details to the portal, your Assessor will be in touch for your induction. We have resources online to assist you in achieving this qualification and an online training course to get started.

Once you have submitted your answers or workbook your assessor will provide you with feedback and guidance to ensure you meet the required standards. IQA sampling will be carried out throughout and when you have met the required standards your certificate will be claimed.
